Kate shows up looking for Brett, to tell him he has a 7-year-old son, Reid, and that they aren't, in fact, divorced; together, they must figure out how to forgive and where to go from here. (Though reviews are inherently subjective. I prefer to provide some organization to my opinions through the use of a personal rubric. The following notes may contain spoilers.)Plot and Setting: 4.5 -- Plot has unique elements and no major holes, but a few shaky bits. Setting is clear, believable, and consistent. I really enjoyed the letters to each other that are interspersed with the main story. Some of the interactions with other characters (like Kate's 2 encounters with Olivia, or the several encounters with Sandy, or even involvement in Tom's date with Tammy) seemed unfinished, and therefore unnecessary. Characters: 4 -- Mostly relatable, realistic, interesting, dynamic characters. Even minor characters have depth. I can understand Brett not sending his emails, and repeatedly trying to locate Kate, and loving her so readily again even with all her secrets. I can less easily understand Kate. I guess her refusal to walk with God is a large part of it, but I can't guite wrap my mind around her loving Brett for all those years, and never reaching out to him. Sure, confessing would be hard, but waiting longer only makes it harder. Sounds like her mother was a difficult woman, but she was spot on in her insistence that Kate talk to Brett. Writing and Mechanics: 4.5 --Few, if any, typos or word errors. Intelligent use of alternating POV. Generally skillful writing. More of that characteristic triple-repeating style, which worked better in some places than in others.

How have I not read anything by Liz Isaacson before now? Yikes! I have a lot of reading to catch up.:)I donâ <sup>™</sup>t typically choose to read books where the characters are married, but the cover spoke to me and the blurb intrigued. I didnâ <sup>™</sup>t like Kate in the beginning. Never really got her. Like why she asked Brett for a divorce. Why she chose to stay silent about Reid. Why she stuck around and took abuse from a patronizing mother. I mean, she was an adult, why didnâ <sup>™</sup>t she just take her son and live on her own? I didnâ <sup>™</sup>t understand some of her choices, especially toward the end.â œKate felt utterly alone, like she was the only woman stupid enough to make such colossal mistakes.â •Yep. Weâ <sup>™</sup>ve all been there, havenâ <sup>™</sup>t we? So, Kateâ <sup>™</sup>s love and devotion to her son, Reid, and her willingness to take a job and stay on the ranch just so Brett could get to know

Reid, redeemed her. Brett, on the other handâ |â œSheâ <sup>™</sup>d loved the danger in his eyes. The years had changed him, and though his eyes were still pools of ebony, they held more wisdom now. The same passion, but curbed with patience and maturity.â •Heâ <sup>™</sup>s been through three deployments already, suffers from PTSD and a fear of sand. Horses calm him, and heâ <sup>™</sup>s found a sense of peace at Three Rivers Ranch. When Kate shows up and shatters his balance, I couldnâ <sup>™</sup>t blame him for wrestling with forgiveness. Even so, heâ <sup>™</sup>s kind and sweet and really good with Reid. What a hero! Especially when heâ |yikes, I canâ <sup>™</sup>t give that away! Youâ <sup>™</sup>II have to read the book.:)I appreciated the insight from the letters and emails, but toward the end, I felt like they took over the story. The faith thread was subtle, not overpowering or preachy, and the romance the perfect balance of speak and sizzle.
