Well, that's it. The acclaimed Vertigo series comes to an end with this volume, and now it's time for the final assessment. The final serves up a final confrontation with both of the series major villains. The first is with the employer of Toyota, and is done very well. The second, unfortunately, ended rather anticlimactically. A last second motive change really took the bite out of that arc. Which was especially disappointing, because every other character is given such a great send-off. The series gives us a double length epilogue that may very well be the best epilogue I have ever read.Overall, I say this series had top-tier characters, dialogue, and artwork, and a middling-to-above-average plot. If it would have just relied less on action movie cliche's, it would have earned a full 5 stars. As it stands, I give this series 4.2 stars out of 5. Well worth the read.
